Choral commission for Dr David Ray

Further to the article in the Christmas edition of 'Nottingham in Faith', donations are welcome towards the choral commission in memory of David Ray. David, who died just over a year ago, was Associate Professor of Neurotoxicology at the University of Nottingham, and sang in the St Peter's Choir. The University Medical School in collaboration with St Peter's have commissioned a piece of choral music in David's memory. The work will be written by the accomplished British composer Howard Skempton, and will be based around verses from Ecclesiasticus 38 that concern the role of medicine and physicians.
