Hilary Punnett is currently the organ scholar at Southwell Minster. She began her organ studies in Victoria, Canada, where she was organ scholar at the Church of St John the Divine before moving to Montreal, Quebec, in 2005 to pursue organ studies at McGill University with Dr John Grew. Hilary has a BMus degree (2009) from McGill in organ performance, and was awarded the W Douglas Clark Memorial prize, the Douglas Mackey prize, and the Gerald Wheeler award for organ at McGill. She was awarded a SSHRC Master's Scholarship for the 2010-11 scholastic year and was a prizewinner in the 2010 Lynnwood Farnam Organ Competition. She completed her MMus in organ performance at McGill in the spring of 2011. She was also assistant organist at Christ Church Cathedral, Montreal under the direction of Patrick Wedd from 2009-2011.
