## **St Peter's Church, Nottingham: Heritage Outreach Project Officer post**

Thank you for expressing interest in our Heritage Outreach Project Officer post. St Peter's Church is at an exciting stage in its long history since thanks to a generous grant from the National Lottery Heritage Fund, we are now able to begin a major project to renew the lead on the church roof. Alongside this, the grant also means that we are able to develop a range of Heritage Outreach activities; the post which is currently being advertised is for a part-time project officer who will oversee and co-ordinate these.

The church is located in a very busy area of Nottingham, at the heart of the city centre. The church building dates back to the 1100s, but now incorporates several contemporary artistic features. It attracts considerable numbers of visitors as well as hosting regular activities which connect with groups such as rough sleepers, those suffering from mental illness, and school children. We have strong links with the wider cultural life of the city through music, drama, art and photography.

All this means that we are in an excellent position from which to build up our planned heritage outreach activities. More details of these are given in the documents which constitute this application pack. I should say that although we are all currently subject to various constraints as a result of coronavirus, we can still make progress in certain aspects of these projects.
