

The Parish of St Peter and All Saints, Nottingham

Heritage Outreach Project Officer

Part-time, average 15 hours a week, fixed term contract for one year

Salary: £1,250 per month

St Peter's Church has been awarded funding by the National Lottery Heritage Fund for the project 'City Stories: Then and Now'. The grant has enabled the church to address long-standing roof repairs as well as deliver a wide range of outreach activities. The Parochial Church Council therefore seeks to appoint an experienced and dynamic Heritage Outreach Project Officer to work with the project steering group over a year from September 2020.

Our original plan was to provide projects which would allow the vulnerable people who regularly use the church to feel ownership of the space, benefit from greater well-being and develop useful skills for employment. This is still our aim, but now within the constraints of social distancing. We also have plans for young people from inner-city schools (which have a high percentage of 'Pupil Premium' families) to access engaging heritage activities. We would like to address gaps in the current curriculum, to engage with pupils about the role played by the church in the city's history, and to give them the desire to return to the building with their families by introducing them to the peace and tranquillity of our beautiful building.

The project also includes the creation of a new guidebook for St Peter's, and the addition of new material on the social and physical heritage of the church to the parish website.
