Church Opening Times

During the current Tier 5 Lockdown, we are fortunate to be able to continue to offer a space for private prayer as well as public services. However, as the situation continues to worsen, we have decided to scale back the number of services that we hold during the week.

Therefore, St Peter's will continue to hold a service on Thursdays (11am), but the Sunday morning service (10.45am) will now be live streamed behind closed doors (available live at 10.45am at nottinghamchurches.org/webcasts, or to watch again from the following day). The Holy Communion Service at 8.15am on Sundays is also temporarily postponed. St Peter's will be open for private prayer on Thursdays, 10am - 3pm.

All Saints' will continue to offer a Eucharist Service on Sunday morning at 10.30am, and will be open for Private Prayer on Tuesdays 11am-1pm.

Proposed new non-slip surface for the entrance ramp at All Saints' Church

The entrance ramp which leads to the main door at All Saints' Church can become very slippery when weather conditions are poor. It is hard to ensure that the present surface remains safe at all times. We have therefore been exploring possibilities for a new non-slip surface, and our architect, Peter Rogan, has recommended a resin-bound surface produced by a company called Addagrip, which specialises in non-slip surfaces for paths, driveways and similar settings. The surface is made from gravel and resin and is supplied in various colours. The cost of carrying out this work would be £1,474. In view of the difficult financial circumstances which our parish continues to face, we are therefore inviting contributions from church members towards the cost of this project. If you can help, please make your cheque out to 'St Peter and All Saints PCC', and accompany it with a Gift Aid declaration if possible. Cheques can be posted to the parish office.
