Nottingham is a great city. It's young and vibrant with plenty of culture, two universities, a strong sporting tradition, various forms of night life, and much more. It has a history of questioning and challenging when things in society don't seem right, going back to Robin Hood. There's a lot going on in our two churches; we have of course been affected by Covid-19 in various ways, but in normal times we work with rough sleepers, asylum seekers, people with mental health problems, and other vulnerable people. There is a thriving Church cafe (the St Peter's Coffee Room), and a Peace Garden at All Saints'. We have done considerable work on environmental issues over the last few years, and we have an Overseas Committee which leads our activities in relation to organisations and causes around the world. We are a member of Inclusive Church. Worship is centred on the Sunday Eucharist, in both churches, which is accompanied by a range of other services through the week.

We are looking for someone who is ready to learn but also able to contribute, drawing upon your particular skills and interests. There is healthy theological discussion in both churches, and a strong team of clergy and lay leaders within which you will work. You may be exploring ordination, or you may perhaps be looking for a way to give something of yourself to God, the Church and the community in a way which will make a difference to people's lives.
