### **Ukraine - Urgent Appeal**

We have made contact with the Ukrainian and Polish Catholic churches in Nottingham, which are channeling donations to partner churches and charities in Ukraine and on the border between Poland and Ukraine, in order to support those who have been affected by the war. During Lent our parish is appealing for donations to support their work, and you are asked to give generously at this time of massive need. Father David Senyk of the Ukrainian Church in Sneinton has said that:

- £8 will provide two blankets
- £23 will provide a food and hygiene pack for an adult for a month
- £70 will provide a food and hygiene pack for a family for a month
- Other services being provided include medical and pharmaceutical packs, counselling services and support services for children.

## **Preparation of revised Electoral Roll**

Every year, the Electoral Roll in each parish is revised and the procedure includes the receipt of applications of those wishing to apply for their names to be added. All eligible members of the congregations are encouraged to be on the Electoral Roll to give a true picture of our church and parish membership. Only people whose names are entered on the Roll by **Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> April** will be entitled to take part in the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM), to be held on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> April 2022 at All Saints' Church. May I stress that if your name is on the current Electoral Roll you do NOT need to re-apply now as names are carried forward to 2025!

Application forms for membership of the Electoral Roll are available at the back of the churches. Please place completed forms in the box provided or hand it to one of the churchwardens or, at St Peter's, directly to me. Once the revised Roll is prepared, a full list of names of people on it will be posted at the back of each church for inspection to enable any omission or other error to be corrected.

## **Covid-19: Contact arrangements at St Peter's**

Now that the government has discontinued its Test and Trace system, churches are no longer asked to collect the contact details of those attending services. However, we would like to give continued reassurance that we take very seriously the safety of those coming to St Peter's, recognising that some people remain vulnerable.

You are therefore invited, if you wish, to complete the form available at the back of church, which will enable you to be contacted if a member of the church develops Covid-19. This will enable you to take any precautions which you think might be appropriate. Please note that the names of any people who develop Covid-19 will not be divulged, and that your own contact details will be kept confidential.

These new arrangements will supersede the taking of contact details each week from those attending Sunday services. Forms can be found at the back of church or from a steward.

## **Intercessions at St Peter's Church**

Leading the intercessions in the Sunday service is a valued ministry, and enables those who do so to make an important contribution to worship. It would be good, however, if there were more people who could do this as part of the intercessors' rota. Could you consider offering to help in this way? While intercessors usually prepare their own prayers, it is also possible to use resources, including books of intercessions which are suggested for each Sunday of the year; these can be adapted and developed as appropriate. It would also be possible to read intercessions which had been drafted by a member of the clergy or another member of the church. If you might be able to do this, please approach one or the clergy or churchwardens. Training will be given!
